making sense of psychiatric diagnosis aims to cut through the misinformation stigma and assumptions that surround mental illness and give a clear picture of what mental illness really is the book pairs diagnostic criteria and descriptions for a variety of mental illnesses in the dsm 5 with nineteen first hand narrative accounts of what it s like to live with those conditions the book is also infused with the author s own experience as a mental health nurse and person living with depression with the fusion of diagnostic information clinical experience and lived experience this book offers a unique well rounded perspective on the reality of mental illness

the cultural formulation interview cfi is a product of the arduous process that resulted in publication of the dsm 5 and only one book dsm 5 handbook of the cultural formulation interview provides clinicians with the background and guidance they need to implement the cfi the handbook teaches the reader how to conduct a cultural assessment using the cfi which consists of three types of semistructured interviews although the cfi was not designed to be the sole basis for making a clinical diagnosis it can be used in research and clinical settings to enhance clinical understanding and decision making the volume presents techniques to help providers situate their work within the context of a patient s culture to enhance communication not only with those of different cultures but across all clinical encounters especially instructive are the supplemental videos that demonstrate application of the cfi components through the use of clinical vignettes clinicians will of course find the dsm 5 handbook of the cultural formulation interview indispensable but administrators policy makers advocates and other practitioners who work collaboratively to engage patients in the mental health care process will also value its clarity and comprehensiveness

in 2013 the american psychiatric association published the 5th edition of its diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders dsm 5 often referred to as the bible of psychiatry the manual only classifies mental disorders and does not explain them or guide their treatment while science should be the basis of any diagnostic system to date there is no knowledge on whether most conditions listed in the manual are true diseases moreover in dsm 5 the overall definition of mental disorder is weak failing to distinguish psychopathology from normality in spite of all the progress that has been made in neuroscience over the last few decades the psychiatric community is no closer to understanding the etiology and pathogenesis of mental disorders than it was fifty years ago in making the dsm 5 prominent experts delve into the debate about psychiatric nosology and examine the conceptual and pragmatic issues underlying the new manual while retracing the historic controversy over dsm considering the political context and economic impact of the manual and focusing on what was revised or left unchanged in the new edition this timely volume addresses the main concerns of the future of psychiatry and questions whether the dsm legacy can truly improve the specialty and advance its goals

the conceptual evolution of dsm 5 highlights recent advances in our understanding of cross cutting factors relevant to psychiatric diagnosis and nosology these include developmental age related aspects of psychiatric diagnosis and symptom presentation underlying neuro circuitry and genetic similarities that may clarify diagnostic boundaries and inform a more etiologically based taxonomy of disorder categories and gender culture specific influences in the prevalence of and service use for psychiatric disorders this text also considers the role of disability in the diagnosis of mental disorders and the potential utility of integrating a dimensional approach to psychiatric diagnosis a powerful reference tool for anyone practicing or studying psychiatry social work psychology or nursing the conceptual evolution of dsm 5 details the proceedings from the 2009 american psychopathological association s annual meeting in its chapters readers will find a thorough review of the empirical evidence regarding the utility of cross cutting factors in nosology as well as specific suggestions for how they may be fully integrated into the forthcoming fifth edition of diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders

the dsm 5 promises to be a major reformulation of psychopathology and no section is likely to change diagnostic practice more than that of personality pathology unlike the dsm iv the dsm 5 personality disorders will be conceptualized as involving core deficits in interpersonal and self functioning and will utilize a hybrid assessment model involving both pathological trait dimensions and a limited set of personality disorder types these changes are based on empirical and theoretical work conducted during the era of dsm iii iv but nevertheless there is significant disagreement among personality assessors regarding the dsm 5 proposal in this volume several members of the dsm 5 work group offer rationales for the proposal and offer empirical evidence regarding suggested changes and several personality assessment researchers critique the proposal and offer alternative conceptualizations this book was originally published as a special issue of the journal of personality assessment
