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educators want young people to grow up knowing that writing is an important and deeply satisfying life skill one that helps them make more sense of themselves and their world and one that helps them to communicate effectively sadly too often writing becomes merely an exercise in getting words right or writing to teacher prescribed tasks developing young writers in the classroom explores the principles of developing literacy through authorship allowing children to describe question and celebrate their own experiences and personal creativity the book offers detailed guidance supported by planning documents poetry and prose examples of children s work and stimulating visuals inspiring topics explored include creating a classroom environment which supports an independent writer students lives brought into the classroom finding significance in our experiences the use of memoir for recording experiences description in all kinds of writing choosing and writing about a character writing in all curriculum areas linking reading and writing using other authors as mentors and teachers collaborative learning illustrated throughout with accessible activities and ideas from literature and poetry developing young writers in the classroom is an essential resource for all teachers wishing to inspire writing in the classroom

first published in 1986 following the warnock report schools attempted to integrate the teaching of children with special needs into ordinary classrooms many teachers had no experience of teaching children with special needs and the new developments were likely to pose a substantial challenge this book provides a guidance for inexperienced especially new teachers in how to teach children with special needs in ordinary classrooms an important feature of the book is realism the book grows out of the author s own experiences and research the author describes what really happens and bases his suggestions on practices which are likely to bring results

written between 2019 and 2024 portraits from paris is a novelized memoir of a boarding school childhood in 1970s england interspersed with journalistic sketches of cities as diverse as montevideo kolkata and moscow that draw from the travel studded years between school and the author s move to france along the way gavin cologne brookes reflects on historic events ranging from brexit the covid 19 pandemic and the russian invasion of ukraine to the death of the queen the restoration of notre dame and the paris olympics binding the personal and political together is an oil painter s rendering of his creative evolution building with careful brushwork upon the tints of the craft s discovery in adolescence to arrive at the nuanced hues of artistic maturity

how children learn to read well and what kind of teaching helps them is a scarcely penetrated mystery this book is a fascinating and informative research report by a group of teachers who set out to teach children who have failed to acquire a useful degree of literacy in it they discuss their experiences the authors are presenting evidence about a central and constant problem in education an essential kind of evidence which is often ignored because it is so difficult to collect and present the report presents enough case notes and recordings of lessons and discussions to allow readers to make their own interpretations alongside those of the writers highly informative about many of the central topics of teaching literacy it discusses children s motivation the influence of social and cultural background on learning and different methods of teaching reading

this book the first to focus exclusively on portfolio assessment is practical theoretical and broad in scope offering places to start rather than claiming to be definitive the articles all by teachers with considerable experience in using portfolio grading are free of jargon making sound composition and assessment theory available to every reader regardless of the level of writing taught

a significant body of scholarship examines the production of children s literature by women and minorities as well as the representation of gender race and sexuality but few scholars have previously analyzed class in children s literature this definitive collection remedies that by defining and exemplifying historical materialist approaches to children s literature the introduction of little red readings lucidly discusses characteristics of historical materialism the methodological approach to the study of literature and culture first outlined by karl marx defining key concepts and analyzing factors that have marginalized this tradition particularly in the united states the thirteen essays here analyze a wide range of texts from children s bibles to mary poppins to the hunger games using concepts in historical materialism from

class struggle to the commodity essayists apply the work of marxist theorists such as ernst bloch and fredric jameson to children s literature and film others examine the work of leftist writers in india germany england and the united states the authors argue that historical materialist methodology is critical to the study of children s literature as children often suffer most from inequality some of the critics in this collection reveal the ways that literature for children often functions to naturalize capitalist economic and social relations other critics champion literature that reveals to readers the construction of social reality and point to texts that enable an understanding of the role ordinary people might play in creating a more just future the collection adds substantially to our understanding of the political and class character of children s literature worldwide and contributes to the development of a radical history of children s literature
